

REDUCING OUR IMPACT

Striving for sustainable practices in our product construction, manufacturing process and distribution.

At Workwear Outfitters, we manufacture over half of our apparel in facilities we own and operate. We also own and operate about 75% of our distribution centers. As a result, we're able to closely manage our sustainabilty efforts.





DISTRIBUTION

► DISTRIBUTION CENTERS

We have distribution centers in Tennessee, Texas, California and Canada. With our two largest DC's located in:

- Whites Creek, TN (253,850 sq. ft. facility)
- (162,000 sq. ft. facility)

SUSTAINABILITY EFFORTS

Diversion Rate: The diversion rate for our largest two DC's in 2021 was approximately 95%.
Recycling: The following materials are recycled or reused - Fabric, Cardboard, Paper, Plastic, Wood, and Metal.

- Electricity: Lighting upgrades

 (LED & motion sensors) at
 our two primary DC's were
 responsible for reducing electricity
 consumption by more than 1.5
 million kilowatt hours annually.
 We also participate in the Enel X
 electrical reduction system.
- Transportation: Our Workwear fleet retreads approximately 1,750 tires each year instead of buying new tires, reducing the amount of raw material by more than half; and has tractor air shields for better fuel efficiency.
 Nature: At our Whites Creek facility, they have a certified
- facility, they have a certified Monarch Butterfly Waystation.

MANUFACTURING

MEXICO & HONDURAS (Cutting & Sewing Plants)

We have cutting and sewing plants in Mexico and Honduras with over 4,000 employees.

These plants recycle cardboard, fabric, paper, plastic, wood and scrap metal and deliver these to companies that recycle most of

the items to be used for the formation of other products.

Our manufacturing facilities recycle a large portion of our fabric waste generated from our production process, much of which is used as mattress stuffing or to manufacture cleaning mops. We also return thousands of pounds of scrap bronze to our zipper-maker supplier each year for recycling and reuse.

Our manufacturing facilities are upgrading the refrigerant used in our industrial air conditioning units to R410 and we are discontinuing the use of R22; as



R410 is more efficient and better for the environment. We continuously work on projects that improve energy efficiency; these include lighting retrofits to LED, HVAC upgrades and more efficient air compressors.

We're committed to building a greener future by focusing on continuous improvements and progress towards minimizing our environmental footprint.

► WATERPROOF LITE LEATHERS AT KODIAK

Premium full grain waterproof LITE leathers from ISA TanTec are made with Low Impact to the Environment. The LITE system is fully integrated into the leather tanning process, which is specially designed to



reduce and control water and energy usage, as well as limit the amount of chemicals used.



► RECYCLED PLASTIC TEXTILES

• At Kodiak

We incorporate recycled plastics into textile components including

mesh uppers, linings and laces. These components vary by style.

• With Image Authority Programs Several products including fleece caps, fleece jackets and insulated field vests that use Ecospun Fleece made from 100% Recycled Plastic are included in some customer programs.

SOURCING RESPONSIBLY Ensuring global compliance and recognizing labor standards.

At Workwear Outfitters, we partner with 3rd party global compliance firms to perform periodic factory inspections to ensure compliance with our global compliance principles.





GLOBAL COMPLIANCE PRINCIPLES

The Global Compliance Principles represent our commitment to our suppliers and our customers that each piece of apparel and footwear produced in our name will be made consistent with internationally recognized labor standards, such as the U.N. Global Compact Principles and the International Labor Organization's doctrine for human rights.

TERMS OF ENGAGEMENT

Our Terms of Engagement serve as the cornerstone of our relationship with external factories. In order for a factory to produce our products, every contracted supplier must sign our Terms of Engagement document confirming that they will comply with our global compliance principles.

ENVIRONMENTAL GUIDELINES FOR MANUFACTURERS

We use a 3rd party to conduct compliance inspections which includes a section to check that factories adhere to local environmental laws.

FACTORY AUDIT PROCEDURE

We have partnered with 3rd party global compliance firms to perform periodic compliance inspections on factories that produce our products. These compliance inspections are based on our 17 global compliance principles. Our global principles will assist manufacturers in providing a fair, ethical, safe and healthy working environment. As stipulated in our Terms of Engagement document, our manufacturers must follow all relevant local laws as well.

RESTRICTED SUBSTANCE POLICY & LIST

Workwear Outfitters' Restricted Substance List (RSL) is a core component of WWOF's global product safety policies. It identifies the chemical substances that are restricted or limited in WWOF products. The RSL applies to raw materials and component parts supplied by or used by our facilities and business partners in the manufacture of WWOF products. The RSL, the RSL Supplier Compliance Agreement, and our Reasonable Testing Program help us offer the best quality products to our customers to support their workwear needs.





SUPPORTING OUR COMMUNITY

Making a difference in the communities we live and work.

Workwear Outfitters is committed to making positive change in the communities in which we operate. We encourage and empower our associates to get involved in service opportunities that are important to them. We also donate product to charities every year (we started tracking in July with approximate value around \$36,500 as of December 2022).
